Accelerated Reader Curriculum Guide 2025 - 2026

Mission Statement

To foster the love of reading in all children through a software program that motivates, monitors, and manages student reading practice.

Goal

To improve reading by accelerating growth in reading ability, developing lifelong learners and critical thinkers, and improving test scores.

Eligible Participants: **1st grade students** will participate in AR during the first/second quarter per teacher recommendation. All 1st grade students will participate during the third and fourth quarter. **All 2nd-6th grade students** must participate fully in the AR program during all quarters and will be given a formative grade based off of a graded rubric each marking period. In **7th and 8th grade**, AR will be an incentive program only. Teachers will send students the necessary information.

Reaching the Goal (Also see requirements chart below)

3 components must be met in order for the student to reach 100% of his/her goal:

1. Reading at his/her **set** book level or above. If a student tests below his/her lowest level, the test will be deactivated. This remains the same to reach Points Club.
2. Achieve average of 80% or above on comprehension on tests
3. Earn required book points until reaching 100% of points goal

Formative Grade

Students in Grades **2nd-6th** will receive a **formative** Reading grade each quarter based on their performance in reaching their AR goal.

***Teacher selected novels** read in class **MAY NOT** count toward students' AR points because AR is based off of independent reading.

****Students MAY NOT** test on more than **two books** in one day.

*****Students may check out two** library books at a time only with parent permission. Parents must send an email to Kathryn Huggett at khuggett@hgschool.org to give your child permission to checkout two books.

******Students in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade** are given 15 minutes of AR time in class each day to read, test, check in/out books as needed.

*******Students in 5th/6th** grade take their AR tests with their language arts teachers when ready, and they can visit the library to check in/out books in language arts classes as needed.

Home Connect

Parents will receive a personalized letter – a Home Connect report, with student login information, before the first AR quarter. Parents are encouraged to monitor their child's progress by visiting the Home Connect option of the RenLearn website. This is a parent's way of monitoring progress from home.

Incentives

Points Club – Students will be challenged to become a member of the “Points Club.” Once a student reaches his/her quarterly goal, he/she should be encouraged to continue reading and earning points. Students who reach the required points by the end of the AR period for the 4th 9 weeks will become a member. Students reaching this status will be awarded a medal at the end of each quarter during morning assembly. At the end of the school year, Points Club students will be invited for a treat.

To be a member of the “Points Club” students must reach the following points:

1 st graders – 25	2 nd graders – 50	3 rd graders – 75
4 th graders – 100	5 th graders – 125	6 th graders - 150
7 th graders – 175	8 th graders - 200	

In addition, the student in each grade who has the highest points at the end of the school year will be recognized.

October 13 to December 12	-	AR 2nd quarter of AR (8 weeks)
January 6 to March 6	-	AR 3rd quarter of AR (8 weeks)
March 17 to May 1	-	AR 4th quarter of AR (6 weeks)

No testing allowed 10/6/25 to 10/10/25, 12/15/25 to 12/19/25, 3/9/25 to 3/13/25, and after May 1, 2025 - the end of AR for the year.

The library WILL NOT be open before or after school for testing.
